DIRECTIONS

From Frenchtown, take Route 29 South. Pass Raven Rock/Bull's Island. Turn left at Federal twist Road. Take your next right onto Rosemont Raven Rock Road. The Preserve is on the left before the steel bridge.

From Stockton, take Route 29 North. Turn right at Federal Twist Road. Take your next right onto Rosemont Raven Rock Road. The Preserve is on the left before the steel bridge.

From the North, Take Route 519 South. Just after the Rosemont Cafe and the curve in the road, bear right on Raven Rock Road. You will pass the Trailhead for the Wescott Preserve on your right. Cross the steel bridge and the parking lot will be on your right.
